Prayer Guide for Intimacy

<u>Personal Prayer</u>: Below is a list of God's names; one for each day of the month. These names remind us of God's character. You are encouraged to take the name that is listed for the day and reflect on that characteristic of God. Take a few minutes to consider on how God has revealed this aspect of His character in your life. Then thank and praise Him for who He is.

<u>Family Mealtime Prayer:</u> Write the names of God on index cards or separate slips of paper and at mealtime, draw out one card and praise God for who He is as you also thank God for His provision and time together.

Corporate Prayer Meetings:

Take time at the beginning of your weekly prayer meeting to praise God for who He is. Focus on 2-4 names of God each week and vary which names you use. Then spend 10 minutes or more in silent waiting on God. After the time of waiting let individuals share what God revealed to them.
