Iowa Yearly Meeting of Friends YOUTH MISSION SCHOLARSHIP FUND GUIDELINES

The scholarship is available for mission trips as determined by the following guidelines:

Applicants

- 1. Must be regular attenders or members of an Iowa Yearly Meeting Local Meeting.
- 2. Age: Ninth graders through college
- 3. The projects or mission trip for which the applicant is requesting the scholarship will include Friends works, but will not be restricted only to Friends projects.

Application

- 1. Those desiring to apply for scholarship money will need to submit a one-page essay articulating the reasons why they want to go and what they would want to learn from the experience. The following information must be included:
 - Applicants: age, name, address, telephone number, local Friends meeting, pastor's name, and e-mail address
 - Description of project. Define the purpose, goals, plan, etc.
 - Name of mission and organization you are sponsored by.
 - Amount of total funds needed.
 - Dates of the mission.
- 2. Application must include a letter of recommendation from the pastor of the meeting the applicant attends.
- 3. Application should be made six to eight weeks before their particular trip. Deadlines for applications are October 1, January 1, April 1 and July 1. The scholarship will be made on a percentage basis determined by the committee up to a maximum of \$150. Funds are limited so apply as early as possible.
- 4. By accepting a scholarship, the applicant agrees to the following terms:
 - To prepare and send the Scholarship Committee a report on their experience. The report must be turned in within 30 days following the return from the trip.
 - To return funds granted if the applicant does not complete the mission.

The Scholarship Committee is the Iowa Yearly Meeting Missions Committee.
