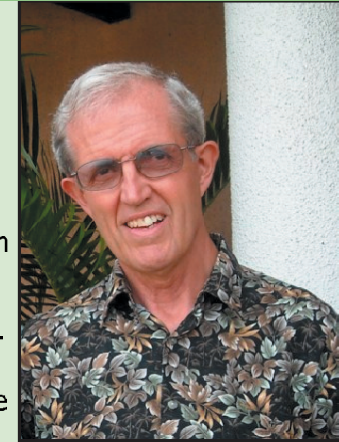
**Jr./Sr. High youth will stay together in cabins and participate in programming, unless they choose to stay with parents.

I recently completed 25 years as a professor of missions at George Fox University in Newberg, Oregon. We have three adult daughters and one grandchild.
